Title: Interdisciplinarity and innovation in a

UniCat from a sociological point of view

Abstract:

As an Excellence Cluster, UniCat aims at being more innovative than traditional ways of doing research by systematically using the advantages of interdisciplinary research. E.g., UniCat's website states: "Our long-term goal is to build a reliable knowledge base across the scientific disciplines for the design and synthesis of new active materials.
